Praying for Destiny Fulfilling Identity

What a remarkable HOPE is found in the Bible for all the families of the earth. We continue today looking at Identity. The Lord is renewing a right identity for released destiny! The Lord is doing this work quickly as we respond to His Word. The foundation of the covenant provides the promises of God that are unlocked by faith.

The Word makes clear that it is the Lord who initiated the covenant with Abraham through which all the families of the earth are blessed. I keep repeating that because we need that revelation! How is the Father, Son and Holy Spirit involved in the covenant?

A. Father: The Originator & Initiator of the covenants. The STATEMENT of the covenant. Working TO us.

B. Son: The Sacrifice, Ratifier, Mediator. The BLOOD of the covenant. Working FOR us.

C. Holy Spirit: The Executor. The SEAL of the Covenant. Working IN us.

In the ancient covenant ceremony the persons entering into covenant would literally stand in an open field and go through a gracious ceremony affirming the covenant. The first step they would perform is THE EXCHANGING OF ROBES. In this step they would literally exchange their robes, or outer coats/garment in a dramatic fashion. Hidden in this ancient rite is a principle we need to fully embrace. The Exchanging of robes in the Old Testament was a type or shadow of a greater truth coming. The Exchanging of Robes literally meant the exchanging of identities! Each of the participants would now be seen, known and recognized by the “coat” they were wearing. Jesus fulfilled this remarkable expression in the New Testament and we are to now clothe, find our identity in Him!

Read Jeremiah 31:31. Also, II Corinthians 5:21, “For He (God the Father) hath made Him (Jesus) to be sin for us, who knew no sin, that we might be made the righteousness of God in Him”. Read I Corinthians 15:22.

WATCH THIS: Paul explains that when we, by faith, entered into the New Covenant our spiritual garment was supernaturally changed when he wrote – “You are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus, for all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ . . . If you belong to Christ, then you are Abraham’s seed, and heirs according to the promise” (Galatians 3:26-29). There are many more Scriptures that we have to share with you to highlight this powerful truth.

The Bible presents a remarkable hope and promise that all the families of the earth are included in His magnificent plan of redeeming love. God has manifest His love in the earth and He will have a people wise and courageous in their ways. A people not of national descent or of a royal birth, but a people who have stepped by

faith into the sovereign plan of God and shape the future to become the history He has desired.

The Father desires to clothe you today in His righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Spirit. He does not just desire the BEST for you BUT He has made full provision for your complete restoration and total success! People often rehearse in their minds right concepts for discovering personal identity. They often read good and edifying books of personal empowerment and even listen to inspiring speakers motivating them to dream of being what they have never been or doing what they have never done and yet, many still feel inadequate and insecure in their identity. In what do you find your identity!

Five Truths That Shape Identity

1. We are the sons and daughters of God by faith in Christ Jesus! (Galatians 3:6)
2. We have been baptized into Christ! (Galatians 3:7) What does this mean?
3. We have clothed ourselves with Christ! (Galatians 3:29)
4. We belong to Christ! (Galatians 3:28)

We are heirs to the greatest promises of God! (Galatians 3:28)

Get ready! The King of Glory is pouring out the manifest glory of His Presence! Your "house" is about to be overwhelmed by the blessing of the Father! Take these Scriptures and ponder on them today during the Communion Fast and reestablish your confidence in who you are in Christ!
